OVERVIEW

Harrington Discovery Institute® (HDI) is issuing a call for proposals in the UK for a new grant award programme to advance promising research into novel treatments for rare diseases. Modelled after its US programmes, HDI is providing UK researchers with a unique opportunity for funding and personalised discovery and development support. The two-year Harrington Scholar programme includes £100,000 guaranteed, with the potential to qualify for additional acceleration funding up to £500,000.
